Eligibility

1. B.A. (English Literature) or B.A/B.Sc., Degree with English with four papers under Part I or Part II of this University or any recognized University.
2. B.A/B.Sc.(Ed.) of Mysore University (Four year Integrated Course) with English as one of the subjects, Post Graduate Diploma in Rural Economics and Co-operation conducted by the National Council for Higher Education, New Delhi.
3. Those qualified for M.A., (ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LINGUISTICS) and desire to improve class already obtained should undergo the course for two years.
4. B.O.L. Degree of Annamalai University.

Note:

Persons holding the following Degrees are **NOT** eligible for admission to M.A. (ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LINGUISTICS)

- a. B.Com. or B.B.A. or B.A. (Special) or B.Sc. (Special) or B.Lit.,
- b. 2 years B.Sc. Degree with Preliminary English.
- c. Diploma in Rural Service Examination (D.R.S) conducted by the National Council for Rural Higher Education, New Delhi.
- d. Those who have passed two papers only in English UG Part I or II or III.
